In the coming year we are looking to replace our secondary unit due to its aging condition. We routinely have both ambulances in service and rotate them to save on wear and tear and mileage. Our call volume has doubled and the demand on our apparatus has increased as well. In 2021 we responded to over 600 calls and our fire department has logged more than 160 calls. Our fire and ambulance personnel continuously take courses to maintain or increase their level level of certifications. GENERAL INFORMATION & FAQs

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF JOINING? First and foremost, you are helping your local emergency medical service provide quality emergency services. Secondly, you are eliminating your out-of-pocket expense under certain circumstances. The cost of emergency services could cost over \$1,400. By becoming a "member", we will waive unpaid balances (excluding deductible) for an emergency service after your insurance company processes the bill.

WHY BUY A MEMBERSHIP IF I PAY AN EMERGENCY SERVICE TAX? First of all, a membership gives YOU the benefit of no out-of-pocket cost, Secondly, WE need your support! Did you know that it costs \$700 per day to keep our ambulance staffed 24/7? The reimbursements we get from insurance companies typically only cover \$40% of our expenses, this is why we need YOUR support.

I AM A MEMBER, WHY DID I GET AN INVOICE? Even if you are a member, we will still bill all your available insurance. Information invoices will be sent to you to keep you informed as to the billing process of your claim. Some insurance companies pay money directly to you instead of us; YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SENDING THE PAYMENT TO US.

WILL YOU TRANSPORT TO THE HOSPITAL OF MY CHOICE? Most insurance companies will pay for transport to the closest appropriate facility. If we transport to a facility that is not the closest appropriate facility and is NOT medically necessary, your insurance may not pay the additional mileage charge. Your membership only covers transportation to the closest appropriate facility.

What does BLS and ALS mean?

A Basic Life Support (BLS) ambulance is staffed by an EMT & a Driver/EMR that respond to both critical and non-critical calls. The BLS company will transport the patient to the hospital in their ambulance.

Advanced Life Support (ALS) is a unit staffed by a Paramedic that responds to higher acuity calls such as cardiac events, strokes, etc. The Paramedic is able to perform more in depth treatment and interventions for these situations such as administer medications, start IV's & EKG's. The ALS provider will transport with the BLS company to the hospital.

If ALS care is required, it will be provided by Penn State Health Life Lion EMS LLC, if available. Other ALS services may be used in place of the primary ALS services if not available.

WHAT IF ANOTHER AMBULANCE COMPANY

TRANSPORTS ME? When 9-1-1 is called, the dispatchers will send the nearest available unit, Millerstown EMS has reciprocal agreements with other Perry County BLS companies. IF our ambulance is unable to provide emergency service for any reason, and you or your dependents are transported by another Perry County BLS company, your membership will be honored and you will not be charged.

WILL YOU BILL MY INSURANCE? We will bill any primary and secondary insurance coverage that you are enrolled in. You will, however, be required to meet any insurance deductible that your insurance company requires you to pay. Once these obligations are met, as a member any balance due will be covered by your membership. Annual insurance deductible are not covered by your membership.

WHAT DOES MY MEMBERSHIP COVER

Your membership will cover any amounts not allowed by your insurance company. Deductibles remain the patient's responsibility. Your membership DOES NOT include any non-emergency or routine transports. The membership covers up to 3 transports to a hospital per patient, per year.

TYPES OF SUBSCRIPTIONS

SINGLE: Covers any single, widowed or divorced person 18 years of age and older. ALS COVERAGE INCLUDED

FAMILY: Entitles a husband, wife and any children under 18 years of age to this coverage. Full-time college students up to age 23 are covered in a family subscription. ALS COVERAGE INCLUDED

GUEST: This covers any guest visiting your home who is NOT a resident of the Millerstown service area. This person will not be billed for excess their insurance company does not cover for the ambulance services provided. ALS is also proivded with this subscription.
